

- Prior to any works commencing, Pan Pac Forest Division and Contractor representatives must complete this form and identify site-specific hazards associated with the proposed works, assess the risks associated with each hazard, evaluate the risks and agree on the risk control methods.
- The contractor must manage any operational hazards or risks specific to their operations via their own onsite hazard identification and risk assessment processes.
- Should any condition arise that causes a risk to increase significantly beyond the control of the Contractor or make a work practice or work environment unsafe, all works must immediately cease and the applicable Pan Pac representative must be immediately contacted to discuss the situation.
