

USE THE FAUNA APP TO RECORD FALCON SIGHTINGS



- The Falcon seen in our forests are under the conservation status At Risk-Recovering.
- Falcon are often confused with another native bird of prey – the hawk (Swamp Harrier), which is not threatened.
- A falcon is ½ the size of a hawk.
- Falcons will ‘dive-bomb’ people during nesting season (Aug-Mar) if they come within a few hundred metres of their nests. If this happens hold a stick above your head and they will aim for this instead.
- Falcons often nest in cutover or in young stands.
- Falcons fly fast with rapid wingbeats – the hawk has a slow flight often with glides.
- **If you see a falcon during the breeding season and within 200m of a logging operation, PLEASE record in the Fauna App and tell your Pan Pac Coordinator.**
