DRIVE TO THE CONDITIONS

- The **underlying** reason for most of our driving incidents and accidents can ultimately be traced back to the driver or drivers involved not driving to the conditions.
- Do **not** drive to the R/T:
 - Using the R/T to communicate with other road users is recommended and will **assist** in safe driving but it does not over-ride driving to the conditions.
 - Always drive expecting a vehicle to be coming the other way.
- Drive at a speed and in a position on the road so you can either stop or pass safely.
- Always keep left.
- On our own forest roads the maximum speed is 50km/hr.
- The above are even more important now that most of our work is in private woodlots. We are travelling on many narrow public roads used by members of the public. **Be considerate and always drive to the conditions.**
