RADIO PROTOCOL

Standard Call-Up Protocol

When entering the forest or leaving an operation always state:

- Who you are e.g. light vehicle, crew bus, loaded truck etc.
- Where you are (using road names and markers)
- Where you intend to go to (using road names and markers), e.g. light vehicle Stihl Road to Willowflat Road

Call ups should be made for the intended route, at regular intervals or marker pegs, and at intersections.

- If unsure of other traffic, stop and ask
- If stopping on a forest road for any reason you must call to let other forest users know when and where you are pulling over and re-call prior to continuing driving back on the road
- If you are carting logs please call “LOADED” or “EMPTY”.

Your radio manner should be spoken clear, professional and with no inappropriate language.
