ROAD CLOSED STOP AND PROCEED

To end confusion on Road Closure, these are the rules you must follow:

Full Road Closure

- “Road Closed” sign in the centre of the road and full width tape or barrier (or road width “Road Closed” banner).
 - This means the Road is **CLOSED** to all traffic, absolutely no access until the person responsible (i.e. the person who erected the signage) re-opens it. You must not move the signage or enter the road until the road is reopened.



Temporary Road Closure – Unmanned

- “STOP – Proceed only when instructed” sign on side of road and full road width tape or barrier (or road width “STOP – Proceed only when instructed” banner).
 - This means the Road is temporarily **CLOSED** to all traffic – absolutely no access until the person has made contact and clearance is given. You can only move the signage and proceed when you have the go ahead.



Flagman Controlled – Temporary Road Closure

- Flagmen with appropriate signage controlling access of traffic through the hazard zone.
 - The flagmen control access.
